Barclays is a British multinational bank and financial services company. According to <u>research</u> released by PSC, War on Want and Campaign Against Arms Trade, it holds over £1bn in shares in, and provides financial services to, nine companies supplying Israel with weapons and military technology, used in its militarised violence against Palestinians.

Honeywell

Honeywell is a US-based arms company. Corporate Watch <u>have reported</u> that components produced by Honeywell were used by Israel in its 2014 aerial bombardment and ground invasion of the besieged Gaza Strip in 2014. Between 2008 and 2021, Honeywell applied to the British government for 30 <u>export licenses</u> to supply weapons and military technology to Israel.
